

King George County Electoral Board Meeting Minutes

November 4th, 2020 – November 6th, 2020

I. Call to order

Nancy Lambert called to order the regular meeting of the King George County Electoral Board at 10:00 a on November 4th, 2020 at King George County Revercombe Building, General Registrar's Office.

II. Roll call

Rick Crookshank conducted a roll call. The following persons were present: John Nelson, Nancy Lambert, Lorrie Gump, and Democrat Party observer, Phyllis Cook.

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Rick Crookshank read the minutes from the last meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

IV. Open issues

- a) Board started canvassing the precincts from the November 3rd, 2020 Presidential Election
 - i) Results of the November 3rd, 2020 Election
 1. Courthouse Precinct 101: Zero Tape Checked, SOR Reviewed, Write-Ins: Presidential/V. Presidential – 6 and House of Representatives – 2, 7 Provisionals
 - a. Numbers match and justify
 2. Passapatanzy Precinct 102: Zero Tape Checked, SOR Reviewed, Write-Ins: Presidential/V. Presidential – 3, Senate – 3, and House of Representatives – 3, 6 Provisionals
 - a. Machine count and Pollbook numbers do not match by one. A screen appeared on one pollbook that said 'Live Backup for Storage...' After that incident, the numbers did not match for the rest of the day.
 3. Monroe Precinct 201: Zero Tape Checked, SOR Reviewed, Write-Ins: Presidential/V. Presidential – 5, Senate – 2, and House of Representatives – 3, 6 Provisionals
 - a. Numbers match and justify
 4. Dahlgren Precinct 301: Zero Tape Checked, SOR Reviewed, Write-Ins: Presidential/V. Presidential – 4, Senate – 4, and House of Representatives – 3, 7 Provisionals

- a. Number of votes cast is one higher than voters checked in. Possible correlation with Passapatanzy as both precincts began having a discrepancy at 4p. (Question of whether there was some issue like a power surge or with so many curbside voters was one not checked in yet was given a ballot which the voter cast.)
5. Shiloh Precinct 401: Zero Tape Checked, SOR Reviewed, Write-Ins: Presidential/V. Presidential – 5, Senate – 1, and House of Representatives – 1, 6 Provisionals
 - a. Numbers match and justify
6. CAP: Zero Tape Checked, SOR Reviewed, Write-Ins: Presidential/V. Presidential – 17, Senate – 2, and House of Representatives – 5
 - a. Numbers match and justify
- b) Meeting recessed at 1:00p until 10:00a on November 6th, 2020.
- c) Meeting reconvened at 10:00a on November 6th, 2020. All present as on November 4th.
 - i) Review of Dahlgren’s Pollbook and ballot count.
 - (1) Discovered that one voter was a curbside and was unchecked in order to code the pollbook as an “outside the polls” but was never checked in again. The numbers once adjusted justify.
 - ii) Board went into Closed Session at 10:30a to consider Provisional Ballots.
 - iii) Board returned to Open Session having counted 28 ballots.
- d) Board finished canvass and certification process of the November 3rd, 2020 Presidential Election.
