Programming

At Your School:

- Booktalks on any subject or grade level (For example: "Great Books for Third Graders" or "College Resources at Your Library")
- Community Helper Days. (What do Librarians do?)
- Library Skills Coaching
- Customized Storytimes ("All About Frogs" or "Transportation")

At the Library:

- Storytimes (You can request to attend one of our weekly storytimes or have a custom one just for your group)

- Reference or Library Skills Instruction (For 4th grade and up, an introduction to print and/or electronic resources available at L.E. Smoot Memorial Library)
